

Mallacoota Airport Pavement Concession Request

(Issued in accordance with CASA Part 139 Manual of Standards and the Mallacoota Aerodrome Manual)

The Mallacoota Airport Pavement Concession is only valid for the operation specified below and shall not be varied or renewed without the authority of the Aerodromes Coordinator or delegate. This concession covers approval from the aspects of pavement strength and surface characteristics only and may be withdrawn at short notice should pavement conditions deteriorate and change.

Taxiway C	5700 kg/0.60 MPa Sealed
Taxiway C2	Natural SFC limited to ACFT below 5,700 kg
Main Terminal Apron	PCR 40/F/D/0.55 MPa/T Sealed

Please note that taxiway's B, C & C2 are restricted to Fire Emergency ACFT & tenants ONLY.

Standard Conditions

- Any NOTAM takes precedence over this pavement concession, regardless of the date of issue.
- When using runways and taxiways, aircraft taxiing is to be confined to the designated centre lines.
- Aircraft using the airport for refuelling purposes only are to ensure the aircraft is not left unattended so other airport users can access the facility.
- Costs associated with pavement damage directly attributable to these operations may be recovered from the operator of the aircraft responsible.
- Operations must comply with all other aerodrome limitations as detailed in the AIP ERSA for Mallacoota Airport.
