SAFETY

- Wear proper clothing and Personal Protective Equipment (P.P.E). Refer to general PPE listed above
- The maximum speed limit on the Newmerella site is 15kph
- Ensure flashing lights are fitted to all mobile plant and they are in working order. Delivery/Contractor vehicles are to use the vehicles Hazard Lights
- Ensure reversing beeper is fitted to mobile plant/vehicles and they are in working order
- Ensure the horn is working whilst using mobile plant/vehicle on site
- Ensure head lights are used during darker hours of the day
- Ensure the Park brake is applied before exiting the mobile plant/vehicle

SCOPE

This plan sets the requirements for:

- The interaction, movement of Loaders, Forklifts, Pick & Carry, Maintenance vehicles, Contractor vehicles, Haulage trucks, Dispatch trucks, Chemical trucks and delivery vehicles throughout the Newmerella site.
- Strict radio protocol to be used on this site
- The movement of visitors and pedestrians throughout the Newmerella site.

DEFINITIONS

Strict Radio Protocol – mandatory to make radio contact when entering Weighbridge.

Mobile Plant/Vehicles – Loaders, Forklifts, Pick & Carry, Maintenance vehicles, Contractor vehicles, Haulage trucks, Dispatch trucks, Chemical trucks and delivery vehicles.

MOBILE PLANT/VEHICLE MOVEMENT AROUND THE SITE

- Plan your trip around the site
- Always drive mobile plant /vehicle to suit the current conditions
- Do not drive through the weighbridge, Dispatch truck loading area unless no other option is available
- Operate or drive defensively; watch out and give way to other mobile plant and vehicles
- Check all directions and behind before reversing
- Advise other mobile plant/vehicle operators on the relevant UHF channels when you are situated behind them
- Advise other mobile plant/vehicle operators of your intention when moving into a shared area
- Advise other mobile plant/vehicle operators when you intend to travel through the area they are working in
- Watch out for pedestrians
- When Mobile Plant/Vehicles need to exit the Newmerella site exit via the Thomas Road exit.

MOBILE PLANT/VEHICLES MOVING INTO WORK AREAS

Mobile plant/vehicle operators are to approach areas where staff are working with **caution** and gain their attention before entering the work area. You can gain the attention of the staff by calling them on UHF channel. This must be done before entering the following work areas: Weighbridge. If a UHF radio is not available sounding your horn or making eye contact is another option to be used.

DELIVERY VEHICLES

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MANAGEMENT PLAN

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0	All delivery vehicles are to make their way directly to the Warehouse. DO NOT drive through the
	weighbridge to gain access to the site. Using UHF radio if fitted announce that you are on site and
	proceed directly to the Warehouse. You are to remain in the Warehouse area during unloading and are
	NOT permitted in other work areas whilst on site.

- Whilst on site the delivery vehicle is to use UHF and use the vehicles Hazard Lights
- Once unloading of the delivery vehicle is completed the driver is to exit via the Thomas Road main exit

UHF RADIO COMMUNICATION PROTOCOL

- UHF radio must be turned onto the relevant Channels
- Mobile plant/vehicle operators are to communicate over the UHF radio of their intention to enter areas such as Weighbridge.
- Mobile plant/vehicle operators working in these areas are to acknowledge the communication and advise of actions required for a safe path through this area
- Where groups of pedestrians are to be shown around the site the person in control is to announce over the UHF radio to advise all mobile plant/vehicle operators of their intentions

PEDESTRIANS

- Pedestrians are to use nominated walkways around the site
- Pedestrians are to give way to mobile plant/vehicles
- Pedestrians are to watch out for and keep clear of all mobile plant /vehicles
- Always try and avoid walking behind mobile plant/vehicles. If you have no other option, make sure the mobile plant/vehicle operator has acknowledged your presence
- Mobile plant/vehicle operators are to acknowledge to pedestrians that they have seen them

PEDESTRIAN NO GO ZONES

Pedestrian No Go Zones are clearly marked and must not be entered.

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
